Day 19 Salvation from God Alone

In that day you will say: "I will praise you, Lord. Although you were angry with me, your anger has turned away and you have comforted me. Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The Lord, the Lord himself, is my strength and my defense; he has become my salvation." With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation. --Isaiah 12

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. --John 14

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.--Acts 4
