## Day 9 Do not Fear

46 God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

2 Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;

3 Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah.

--Psalms 46

So many places, God instructs us not to fear. He tells us to be of good courage. Fear is a lack of faith and trust in God. Father, please help me to put on the helmet of salvation. When I trust in You and receive your salvation, I have no need to fear. Whatever happens, I have You. "O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?" What have I to fear even from death when I have your salvation?
