

Killing Me Softly

Part 2

In Part 1, I presented the basic points that the powers at be are killing us softly. Since the late 1960's, the world's elite were focused on "Population Control" or more aptly described as "Depopulation". It was to be done in such a manner that the world would not recognize that it was being poisoned in the food, the air, the water, and vaccines administered by government agencies under the guise of preventive medicine.

The Club of Rome was created in 1968 by the Morgenthau Group, its original purpose was to create a New World Order by the year 2000. The Club of Rome has a hidden agenda to divide the entire world into ten regions or kingdoms. These ten regions or kingdoms were an administrative measure to manage the grand plan.

In April, 1968, the Club of Rome was founded by members of the original Morgenthau group during a meeting at Rockefeller's private house in Bellagio, Italy. The meeting was organized by Aurelio Peccei, an Italian industrialist who had close relations to the Olivetti Corporation and Fiat. He claimed to have solutions for world peace and prosperity, which could be accomplished through a New World Order.

The Club of Rome was established with 75 prominent industrialists, economists and scientists members from 25 nations. The Bilderberg Group and the Club of Rome are the most important foreign policy arms of the Round table, which is led by the Committee of 300.

Many of the Club of Rome members were drawn from NATO, and they have been able to create a lot of what NATO claims are its policies. Through Lord Carrington, they were able to split NATO into two groups, a left-wing political faction, and its former military alliance.

The 10 Kingdoms are a reference to the Biblical 10 kingdoms of revelation 17:12: ***"And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast."*** Surprisingly, few Bible prophecy teachers ever picked up the Club of Rome and its place in the big picture of Bible prophecy. It is precisely this reason one should not ignore the NGO's or Non-Governmental Agencies. The bureaucrats have no real power but they through writing of policy exercise that which is not theirs.

The Club of Rome acts as a research institute on political, social and economic issues, and claims that *"there is no other viable alternative to the future survival of mankind than a new global community under a single form of government."*

On 17, September, 1973, the Club of Rome published a report entitled the *"Regionalized and Adaptive Model of the Global World System"*, which was authored by Eduard Pestel and Mihajlo Mesarovic. The report revealed the Club's intention to divide the world into ten

economic/political regions, called “Kingdoms”, which would unite the entire world under a common leadership. These regions are:

- North America
- Western Europe
- Japan
- Australia and South Africa
- Eastern Europe
- Latin America
- North Africa and the Middle East
- Main Africa
- South and Southeast Asia
- Centrally Planned Asia

The Club of Rome planned to divide the entire world into ten economic/political regions, which it refers to as ‘kingdoms’. Over the past fifty years, The Club of Rome has worked from behind the scenes in writing, implementing policies that elected politicians would then carry out The Club’s agenda.

The term “Kingdoms” was intentionally left out, when the plan was released in a book entitled *‘Mankind at the Turning Point’*, which stated that the solutions to the problems of the world could only “be developed in a global context.” It was in 1973 when The Club of Rome focused in on Population Control. In 1973, the Club of Rome released a report entitled *‘Limits to Growth’*, which dealt with the problem of overpopulation.

In the August, 1980 edition of *‘Fusion’* magazine, Howard Odum, a marine biologist at the University of Florida, who was a member of the Club of Rome, was quoted, saying: “It’s necessary that the U.S. cut its population by 2/3 within the next 50 years.” He did not mention how this should be accomplished.

During the presidency of Jimmy Carter, a task force was created to expand the “Limits on Growth” document, and on 24 July, 1980, a two-volume report was released entitled “Global 2000 Report” which had been authored by former Secretary of State Cyrus R. Vance. The report, which was presented to President Carter, attempted to project global economic trends for the next two decades, and indicated that there aren’t enough resources on earth to support the expected dramatic increase in the world population. The document says the population of the United States should be reduced by 100 million people by the year 2050.

About half a year later, the Council on Environmental Quality made recommendations based on the document, entitled *‘Global Future: A Time to Act.’* They proposed an aggressive plan to control the population which included contraception, abortion and sterilization. The Iron Mountain Report was a secret document during the days of President John F. Kennedy said that world peace would be impossible because of global population growth. War was necessary to depopulate the world. It should come as no surprise to learn that water, air, and

foods have been poisoned routinely around the planet. Geo-engineering, more commonly referred to as “Chemtrails” began in the early 1990’s. Its agenda was hidden under the name of “Operation Cloverleaf” and the questioning public was told it was deflecting the sun’s rays.

In 2013, I was living in Fredericktown, KY, and while walking down the street to our mail box, a friend of mine back in Pittsburgh called me. We were talking about a number of things, and I made the statement how clear the sky was as blue and clear, and there were no “Chemtrails” in the noon sky. I joked with him about the clean air on sunny days. I had walked my dogs over to the nearby corn field as we talked. Less than ten minutes had passed when I noticed a white “X” being sprayed directly above as we talked. The fact that it was only an “X” marks the spot, I sensed that my cell phone was tapped and someone was sending me a subtle message. It was a bit of irony that I have not forgotten since.

In August, 1982, the “Executive Intelligence Review” released a document entitled “Global 2000: Blueprint for Genocide” which stated the 2 before mentioned Presidential documents “are correctly understood as political statements of intent – the intent on the part of such policy centers as the Council on Foreign Relations, the Trilateral Commission, and the International Monetary Fund, to pursue policies that will result not only in the death of the 120 million cited in the reports, but in the death of upwards of two billion people by the year 2000.” Throughout the world, the Club of Rome has said that genocide should be used to eliminate people who they refer to as “useless eaters”.

In 1976, the U.S. Association of the Club of Rome (USACOR) was created; its purpose was to shut down the U.S. economy gradually. Henry Kissinger was then, and still is, a high ranked member in the service of the Royal Institute for International Affairs, a member of the Club of Rome and the Council on Foreign Relations. The RIIA is one of the “Round Table” groups planning the agenda of the Globalist movement, and based in the UK.

Kissinger had a major role in the attempt to destabilize the U.S. by means of three wars, in the Middle East, Vietnam and Korea. In the first Gulf War the United States Army acted as mercenaries for the Committee of 300 in bringing Kuwait back under its control and at the same time making an example out of Iraq so that other small countries would not attempt anything against the wishes of the Committee.

On August 17, 1988, the President of Pakistan General Muhammad Zia-ul-Haq died during a suspicious airplane crash. It’s rumored the Club of Rome was ordered by the Committee of 300 to eliminate Zia-ul-Haq.

The Turkish Secret Service warned Zia-ul-Haq not to travel by plane, as he was targeted for a mid-air bombing. With this in mind, Zia-ul-Haq took a U.S. team with him as “an insurance policy,” as he commented to his close advisers. On board the flight there were a number of United States officials, including a U.S. Army Defense Intelligence Agency group led by Brigadier-General Herber Wassom and U.S. Ambassador to Pakistan Arnold Lewis Raphel.

It's rumored the Club of Rome sabotaged the airplane with General Muhammad Zia-ul-Haq in it. Shortly after the plane took off, the control tower lost contact with the aircraft. Witnesses who saw the airplane in the air afterward claim it was flying erratically, then nosedived and exploded when it crashed into the ground.

32 people died in the incident, including Chairman Joint Chiefs of Staff Committee General Akhtar Abdur Rahman, close associate of Zia-ul-Haq, Brigadier Siddique Salik, General Herbert M. Wassom, the head of the U.S. Military aid mission to Pakistan and the U.S. Ambassador to Pakistan Arnold Lewis Raphel.

The death of Zia-ul Haq has raised many questions. The investigation of the crash led to the conclusion that the most probable cause of the crash was sabotage. It's also suggested that poisonous gases were released which incapacitated the crew members and passengers, which would explain why no Mayday signal was given. There is no doubt that a team of professionals were behind the crash. The annals of aviation unfortunately are full of rumored hits against individuals working against the plan of the elite such as the Club of Rome and the Committee of 300.

I mentioned the EIR Special Report, and few are familiar with the EIR. The EIR is a well-documented publication – The Executive Intelligence Review that comes out of the UK. Its publisher is the controversial figure Lyndon Larouche. Lonnie Wolfe wrote the Special Report on the Haig-Kissinger “depopulation” policy for the EIR on March 10, 1981.

Below are excerpts from that report:

“Investigations by EIR have uncovered a planning apparatus operating outside the control of the White House whose sole purpose is to reduce the world's population by 2 billion people through war, famine, disease and any other means necessary. This apparatus, which includes various levels of the government is determining U.S. foreign policy. In every political hotspot - - El Salvador, the so-called arc of crisis in the Persian Gulf, Latin America, Southeast Asia and in Africa- the goal of U.S. foreign policy is population reduction. The targeting agency for the operation is the National Security Council's Ad Hoc Group on Population Policy. Its policy-planning group is in the U.S. State Department's Office of Population Affairs, established in 1975 by Henry Kissinger. This group drafted the Carter administration's Global 2000 document, which calls for global population reduction, and the same apparatus is conducting the civil war in El Salvador as a conscious depopulation project.”

"There is a single theme behind all our work-we must reduce population levels," said Thomas Ferguson, the Latin American case officer for the State Department's Office of Population Affairs (OPA). "Either they [governments] do it our way, through nice clean methods or they will get the kind of mess that we have in El Salvador, or in Iran, or in Beirut. Population is a political problem. Once population is out of control it requires authoritarian government, even fascism, to reduce it "The professionals," said Ferguson, "aren't interested in lowering population for humanitarian reasons. That sounds nice. We look at resources and

environmental constraints. We look at our strategic needs, and we say that this country must lower its population-or else we will have trouble."

"So steps are taken. El Salvador is an example where our failure to lower population by simple means has created the basis for a national security crisis. The government of El Salvador failed to use our programs to lower their population. Now they get a civil war because of it.... There will be dislocation and food shortages. They still have too many people there."

"Civil wars are somewhat drawn-out ways to reduce population, the OPA official added. "The quickest way to reduce population is through famine, like in Africa or through disease like the Black Death," all of which might occur in El Salvador. Ferguson's OPA monitors populations in the Third World and maps strategies to reduce them. Its budget for FY 1980 was \$190 million; for FY 1981, it will be \$220 million. The Global 2000 report calls for doubling that figure. The sphere of Kissinger In 1975, OPA was brought under a reorganized State Department Bureau of Oceans, International Environmental, and Scientific Affairs-- a body created by Henry Kissinger."

"The agency was assigned to carry out the directives of the NSC Ad Hoc Group. According to an NSC spokesman, Kissinger initiated both groups after discussion with leaders of the Club of Rome during the 1974 population conferences in Bucharest and Rome. The Club of Rome, controlled by Europe's black nobility, is the primary promotion agency for the genocidal reduction of world population levels. The Ad Hoc Group was given "high priority" by the Carter administration, through the intervention of National Security Adviser Zbigniew Brzezinski and Secretaries of State Cyrus Vance and Edmund Muskie."

"According to OPA expert Ferguson, Kissinger initiated a full about-face on U.S. development policy toward the Third World. "For a long time," Ferguson stated, "people here were timid" They listened to arguments from Third World leaders that said that the best contraceptive was economic reform and development. So we pushed development programs, and we helped create a population time bomb. "We are letting people breed like flies without allowing for natural causes to keep population down. We raised the birth survival rates, extended life-spans by lowering death rates, and did nothing about lowering birth rates."

"That policy is finished. We are saying with Global 2000 and in real policy that you must lower population rates. Population reduction and control is now our primary policy objective- then you can have some development." Accordingly, the Bureau of Oceans, International Environmental, and Scientific Affairs has consistently blocked industrialization policies in the Third World, denying developing nations access to nuclear energy technology--the policies that would enable countries to sustain a growing population. According to State Department sources, and Ferguson himself, Alexander Haig is a "firm believer" in population control."

"We will go into a country," said Ferguson, "and say, here is your goddamn development plan. Throw it out the window. Start looking at the size of your population and figure out

what must be done to reduce it." If you don't like that, if you don't want to choose to do it through planning, then you'll have an El Salvador or an Iran, or worse, a Cambodia." According to an NSC spokesman, the United States now shares the view of former World Bank President Robert McNamara that the "population crisis" is a greater threat to U.S. national security interests than "nuclear annihilation." "Every hot spot in the world corresponds to a population crisis point," said Ferguson who would rename Brzezinski's arc of crisis doctrine the "arc of population crisis."

"This is corroborated by statements in the NSC Ad Hoc Group's April 1980 report. There is "an increased potential for social unrest, economic and political instability, mass migration and possible international conflicts over control of land and resources," says the NSC report. It then cites "demographic pressures" as key to understanding "examples of recent warfare in India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, El Salvador, Honduras, and Ethiopia, and the growing potential for instability in such places as Turkey, the Philippines, Central America, Iran, and Pakistan." Through extraordinary efforts, the Ad Hoc Group and OPA estimate that they may be able to keep a billion people from being born through contraceptive programs."

"But as the Ad Hoc Group's report states, the best efforts of the Shah of Iran to institute "clean programs" of birth control failed to make a significant dent in the country's birth rate. The promise of jobs, through an ambitious industrialization program, encouraged migration toward "overcrowded cities" like Teheran. Now under Ayatollah Khomeini, the "clean programs" have been dismantled. The government may make progress because it has a program "to induce up to half of Teheran's 6 million residents to relocate, as well as possible measures to keep rural migrants from moving to the cities." Behind the back of the President Ferguson and others involved with the OPA and NSC group maintain that the United States will continue a foreign policy based on a genocidal reduction of the world's population."

"We have a network in place of co-thinkers in the government," said the OPA case officer. "We keep going, no matter who is in the White House." But Ferguson reports that the "White House" does not really understand what they are saying and that the President "thinks that population policy means how do we speed up population increase. "As long as no one says differently," said Ferguson, "we will continue to do our jobs."

One of the lieutenants of the Global Elite is the avowed atheist George Soros. He is supposedly the recipient of a 'pipe bomb' along with close to a dozen Democrat politicians. As it turns out, the sender of the fake 'pipe bombs' was one Cesar Altieri Sayoc. Campbell Soup Vice President of Government Affairs Kelly Johnston suggested that Soros' Open Society Foundation planned and is carrying out the 5,000-person caravan making its way from Central America to the U.S. He also said the foundation has an "army of American immigration lawyers waiting at the border." Embedded journalists and Drug Enforcement agents report the illegals were given from \$1,500 to \$7,000 to join the so-called Caravan to the Border.

Although the mainstream media is having a field day with the fact that the 'magabomber' was caught and was so 'obviously' a Trump supporter, many people have legitimate questions about the narrative.

Everything just seems too perfect. *'Forbes'* magazine is already screaming that President Trump's ideology unleashed him... almost as if these accusations were planned. Plus, the FBI was able to identify and capture him within hours of the reports, but they still have no answers about the weird circumstances surrounding the Las Vegas shooter? So, a number of people are questioning the all too perfect narrative and events surrounding last week's incident. The following four reasons are just a few of the questions that logically thinking people have about it.

Number 1. The affiliation from 'Democrat' Immediately Changed to Republican:

In the 2016 to 2015 records of Cesar Altieri Sayoc's (Randazzo) facebook profile (which was immediately scrubbed, but was screen captured by one reporter, showed he was a virulent hater of former President George W. Photo evidence shows Bush with blood on his hands and photos of "Bush and Cheney portrayed as Nazi war criminals in best keeping with far leftist hate groups widely circulated portrayal of the Bush administration as war criminals."

So people are asking, "Are these the photos an average rabid, diehard, dyed in the #MAGA-wool, Trump supporter would sport on their page in 2015?" It seems extremely unlikely. Just seconds after Cesar Altieri Sayoc was apprehended, his public listing identified him as a Democrat. Then moments later, "the listing was updated by someone, changing his listing from Democrat, to 'Republican.'" In fact, he was listed as a democrat since 1980.

Although the MyLife site is a publicly edited page, one reporter "captured his Democrat party affiliation within seconds of the announcement of his apprehension and then watched in amazement as his party affiliation changed from Democrat to Republican before my very eyes, capturing screenshots as quickly as I could to document the changes."

Number 2. The Stickers On the Much Publicized Van Are Weird And Way Too New:

Although the media reports that the images that covered the Trump van were made by Sayoc, but each were laid out with precision, "carefully sized to fit the layout." Who does that? If buying or printing different items at different times, that seems highly impossible.

Likewise, people "can't just go buy off-the-shelf stickers or fliers, and then somehow get them all to line up perfectly by taping them from inside a van. It's completely absurd."

“Not only were those just printed professionally, they have lots of Photoshop work too, especially the cross-hairs.”

Then, many people have asked how long was the stickers in place? He lives in Florida, but there is absolutely no fading on them by the sun. This seems to indicate that the entire appearance was created within the last week, or two, at the most.

Number 3. The Van’s Appearance:

Not only was the van completely spotless, it apparently drove through highly liberal states, delivering at least one package, without anyone even noticing it? That seems suspicious.

Number 4. The Bizarre Facebook Activity:

In the now deleted Facebook page, Sayoc praised Code Pink, “liberal women,” as “the beautiful women of the world.” This doesn’t seem consistent with a conservative.

Also, he “worked at multiple Florida locations, most recently as an events promoter and marketing specialist with the Seminole Hard Rock Casino in Florida, a company owned by the Seminole Tribe and run by Seminole sovereign nation, traditionally, massively and publicly anti-Trump and staunchly Democrat in both their leadership and lucrative Democrat financial support, along with the majority of their enrollment.”

In addition, “multiple posts from the Trump 2016 campaign trail seem to have garnered virtually no attention or acclaim from Sayoc’s sprawling friends list. One post from October 13, 2016 shows selfie video of Cesar Altieri Sayoc at a Donald Trump rally somewhere during the campaign, again, with very blurry lens. Despite being posted for two years, and with a current friends list of 2,775 people, that momentous video #MAGA moment with a supposedly rabid Trump fan at an expectedly raucous Trump rally had tallied only a single “like” by any of Sayoc’s friends list.” Seriously, one like?

These and other questions just make the narrative all too perfect and have many people questioning is Cesar Sayoc was really a democrat operative who was acting a part to make Trump supporters look like the savage attackers that liberals really are.

Since he’s being held in a federal detention center in Miami, with the same sheriff (Israel) who has deep connections to Hillary Clinton and various Muslims groups, it just seems all too convenient for some people to accept.

21 Goals of the Illuminati and The Committee of 300 by Dr. John Coleman (ca. 1993)

1. To establish a One World Government/New World Order with a **unified church and monetary system** under their direction. The One-World Government began to set up its church in the 1920's and 30's, for they realized the need for a religious belief inherent in mankind must have an outlet and, therefore, set up a "church" body to channel that belief in the direction they desired.
2. To bring about the utter **destruction of all national identity and national pride**, which was a primary consideration if the concept of a One-World Government was to work.
3. To engineer and bring about the **destruction of religion**, and more **especially, the Christian Religion**, with the one exception, their own creation as mentioned above.
4. To establish the **ability to control of each and every person through means of mind control** and what **Zbigniew Brzezinski** called **techonotronics**, which would create human-like robots and a system of terror which would make Felix Dzerzhinski's Red Terror look like children at play.
5. To bring about the **end to all industrialization** and **to end the production of nuclear generated electric power** in what they call **"the post-industrial zero-growth society"**. Excepted are the computer- and service industries. US industries that remain will be exported to countries such as Mexico where abundant slave labor is available. As we saw in 1993, this has become a fact through the passage of the **North American Free**

Trade Agreement, known as **NAFTA**. Unemployables in the U.S., in the wake of industrial destruction, will either become opium-heroin and/or cocaine addicts, or become statistics in the elimination of the "excess population" process we know of today as **Global 2000**.

6. To encourage, and eventually **legalize the use of drugs** and **make pornography an "art-form"**, which will be widely accepted and, eventually, become quite commonplace.
7. To bring about **depopulation of large cities** according to the trial run carried out by the Pol Pot regime in Cambodia. It is interesting to note that Pol Pot's genocidal plans were drawn up in the U.S. by one of the Club of Rome's research foundations, and overseen by **Thomas Enders**, a high-ranking State Department official. It is also interesting that the committee is currently seeking to reinstate the Pol Pot butchers in Cambodia.
8. To **suppress all scientific development** except for those deemed beneficial by the Illuminati. **Especially targeted is nuclear energy for peaceful purposes**. Particularly hated are the fusion experiments currently being scorned and ridiculed by the Illuminati and its jackals of the press. Development of the **fusion torch** would blow the Illuminati's conception of "limited natural resources" right out of the window. A fusion torch, properly used, could create unlimited and as yet untapped natural resources, even from the most ordinary substances. Fusion torch uses are legion, and would benefit mankind in a manner which, as yet, is not even remotely comprehended by the public.
9. To cause by means of A) **limited wars** in the advanced countries, B) by means of **starvation** and **diseases** in the **Third World** countries, **the death of three billion people by the year 2050**, people they call "useless eaters". The Committee of 300 (Illuminati) commissioned **Cyrus Vance** to write a paper on this subject of how to bring about such genocide. The paper was produced under the title "**Global 2000 Report**" and was accepted and approved for action by former President James Earl Carter, and Edwin Muskie, then Secretary of States, for and on behalf of the US Government. **Under the terms of the Global 2000 Report, the population of the US is to be reduced by 100 million by the year of 2050.**
10. To **weaken the moral fiber of the nation** and to **demoralize workers** in the labor class **by creating mass unemployment**. As jobs dwindle due to the post-industrial zero growth policies introduced by the Club of Rome, the report envisages demoralized and discouraged workers resorting to alcohol and drugs. The youth of the land will be encouraged by means of rock music and drugs to rebel against the status quo, thus undermining and eventually destroying the family unit. In this regard, the Committee commissioned Tavistock Institute to prepare a blueprint as to how this could be achieved. Tavistock directed **Stanford Research** to undertake the work under the direction of **Professor Willis Harmon**. This work later became known as the "**Aquarian Conspiracy**".

11. To **keep people everywhere from deciding their own destinies by means of one created crisis after another and then "managing" such crises**. This will confuse and demoralize the population to the extent where faced with too many choices, apathy on a massive scale will result. In the case of the US, an agency for Crisis Management is already in place. It is called the **Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)**, whose existence I first enclosed in 1980.
12. To introduce new cults and continue to boost those already functioning which include rock music gangsters such as **the Rolling Stones** (a gangster group much favored by European Black Nobility), and all of the Tavistock-created rock groups which began with **the Beatles**.
13. To continue to **build up the cult of Christian Fundamentalism** begun by the British East India Company's servant Darby, which **will be misused to strengthen the Zionist State of Israel by identifying with the Jews through the myth of "God's chosen people"**, and by donating very substantial amounts of money to what they mistakenly believe is a religious cause in the furtherance of Christianity.
14. To press for the spread of religious cults such as **the Moslem Brotherhood, Moslem Fundamentalism**, the Sikhs, and to carry out mind control experiments of the Jim Jones and "Son of Sam" type. It is worth noting that the late **Khomeini was a creation of British Military Intelligence Div. 6, MI6**. This detailed work spelled out the step-by-step process which the US Government implemented to put Khomeini in power.
15. To **export "religious liberation" ideas** around the world so as **to undermine all existing religions, but more especially the Christian religion**. This began with the "Jesuit Liberation Theology", that brought an end to the Somoza Family rule in Nicaragua, and which today is destroying El Salvador, now 25 years into a "civil war". Costa Rica and Honduras are also embroiled in revolutionary activities, instigated by the Jesuits. One very active entity engaged in the so-called liberation theology, is the Communist-oriented Mary Knoll Mission. This accounts for the extensive media attention to the murder of four of Mary Knoll's so-called nuns in El Salvador a few years ago. The four nuns were Communist subversive agents and their activities were widely documented by the Government of El Salvador. The US press and the new media refused to give any space or coverage to the mass of documentation possessed by the Salvadorian Government, which proved what the Mary Knoll Mission nuns were doing in the country. 16. To **cause a total collapse of the world's economies** and engender total political chaos.

18. Both Soros and his “Open Society Foundations” provide funding directly or indirectly to over 200 US organizations.

- [Advancement Project](#): This organization works to organize “communities of color” into politically cohesive units while disseminating its leftist worldviews and values as broadly as possible by way of a sophisticated communications department.
- [Air America Radio](#): Now defunct, this was a self-identified “liberal” radio network.
- [Al-Haq](#): This NGO produces highly politicized reports, papers, books, and legal analyses regarding alleged Israeli human-rights abuses committed against Palestinians.
- [All of Us or None](#): This organization seeks to change voting laws — which vary from state to state — so as to allow ex-inmates, parolees, and even current inmates to cast their ballots in political elections.
- [Alliance for Justice](#): Best known for its activism *vis a vis* the appointment of federal judges, this group consistently depicts Republican judicial nominees as “extremists.”
- [America Coming Together](#): Soros played a major role in creating this group, whose purpose was to coordinate and organize pro-Democrat voter-mobilization programs.

- [America Votes](#): Soros also played a major role in creating this group, whose get-out-the-vote campaigns targeted likely Democratic voters.
- [America's Voice](#): This open-borders group seeks to promote “comprehensive” immigration reform that includes a robust agenda in favor of amnesty for illegal aliens.
- [American Bar Association Commission on Immigration Policy](#): This organization “opposes laws that require employers and persons providing education, health care, or other social services to verify citizenship or immigration status.”
- [American Bridge 21st Century](#): This Super PAC conducts opposition research designed to help Democratic political candidates defeat their Republican foes.
- [American Civil Liberties Union](#): This group opposes virtually all post-9/11 national security measures enacted by the U.S. government. It supports open borders, has rushed to the defense of suspected terrorists and their abettors, and appointed former New Left terrorist [Bernardine Dohrn](#) to its Advisory Board.
- [American Constitution Society for Law and Policy](#): This Washington, DC-based think tank seeks to move American jurisprudence to the left by recruiting, indoctrinating, and mobilizing young law students, helping them acquire positions of power. It also provides leftist Democrats with a bully pulpit from which to denounce their political adversaries.
- [American Family Voices](#): This group creates and coordinates media campaigns charging Republicans with wrongdoing.

- [American Friends Service Committee](#): This group views the United States as the principal cause of human suffering around the world. As such, it favors America’s unilateral disarmament, the dissolution of American borders, amnesty for illegal aliens, the abolition of the death penalty, and the repeal of the Patriot Act.
- [American Immigration Council](#): This non-profit organization is a prominent member of the open-borders lobby. It advocates expanded rights and amnesty for illegal aliens residing in the U.S.
- [American Immigration Law Foundation](#): This group supports amnesty for illegal aliens, on whose behalf it litigates against the U.S. government.
- [American Independent News Network](#): This organization promotes “impact journalism” that advocates progressive change.
- [American Institute for Social Justice](#): AISJ’s goal is to produce skilled community organizers who can “transform poor communities” by agitating for increased government spending on city services, drug interdiction, crime prevention, housing, public-sector jobs, access to healthcare, and public schools.
- [American Library Association](#): This group has been an outspoken critic of the Bush administration’s War on Terror — most particularly, Section 215 of the [USA Patriot](#)

[Act](#), which it calls “a present danger to the constitutional rights and privacy rights of library users.”

- [The American Prospect, Inc.](#): This corporation trains and mentors young leftwing journalists, and organizes strategy meetings for leftist leaders.
- [Amnesty International](#): This organization directs a grossly disproportionate share of its criticism for human rights violations at the United States and Israel.
- [Applied Research Center](#): Viewing the United States as a nation where “structural racism” is deeply “embedded in the fabric of society,” ARC seeks to “build a fair and equal society” by demanding “concrete change from our most powerful institutions.”
- [Arab American Institute](#) Foundation: The Arab American Institute denounces the purportedly widespread civil liberties violations directed against Arab Americans in the post-9/11 period, and characterizes Israel as a brutal oppressor of the Palestinian people.
- [Aspen Institute](#): This organization promotes radical environmentalism and views America as a nation plagued by deep-seated “structural racism.”
- [Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now](#): This group conducts voter mobilization drives on behalf of leftist Democrats. These initiatives have been notoriously marred by fraud and corruption.
- [Ballot Initiative Strategy Center](#): This organization seeks to advance “a national progressive strategy” by means of ballot measures—state-level legislative proposals that pass successfully through a petition (“initiative”) process and are then voted upon by the public.
- [Bend The Arc: A Jewish Partnership for Justice](#): This organization condemns Voter ID laws as barriers that “make it harder for communities of color, women, first-time voters, the elderly, and the poor to cast their vote.”
- [Bill of Rights Defense Committee](#): This group provides a detailed blueprint for activists interested in getting their local towns, cities, and even college campuses to publicly declare their opposition to the Patriot Act, and to designate themselves “Civil Liberties Safe Zones.” The organization also came to the defense of self-described radical attorney [Lynne Stewart](#), who was convicted in 2005 of providing material support for terrorism.
- [Black Alliance for Just Immigration](#): This organization seeks to create a unified movement for “social and economic justice” centered on black racial identity.
- [Blueprint North Carolina](#): This group seeks to “influence state policy in North Carolina so that residents of the state benefit from more progressive policies such as better access to health care, higher wages, more affordable housing, a safer, cleaner environment, and access to reproductive health services.”
- [Brennan Center for Justice](#): This think tank/legal activist group generates scholarly studies, mounts media campaigns, files amicus briefs, gives pro bono support to activists, and litigates test cases in pursuit of radical “change.”
- [Brookings Institution](#): This organization has been involved with a variety of internationalist and state-sponsored programs, including one that aspires to facilitate the establishment of a U.N.-dominated world government. Brookings Fellows have also called for additional global collaboration on trade and banking; the expansion of

the Kyoto Protocol; and nationalized health insurance for children. Nine Brookings economists signed a petition [opposing President Bush's tax cuts](#) in 2003.

- [Campaign for America's Future](#): This group supports tax hikes, socialized medicine, and a dramatic expansion of social welfare programs.
- [Campaign for Better Health Care](#): This organization favors a single-payer, government-run, universal health care system.
- [Campaign for Youth Justice](#): This organization contends that “transferring juveniles to the adult criminal-justice system leads to higher rates of recidivism, puts incarcerated and detained youth at unnecessary risk, has little deterrence value, and does not increase public safety.”
- [Campus Progress](#): A project of the Soros-bankrolled [Center for American Progress](#), this group seeks to “strengthen progressive voices on college and university campuses, counter the growing influence of right-wing groups on campus, and empower new generations of progressive leaders.”
- [Casa de Maryland](#): This organization aggressively lobbies legislators to vote in favor of policies that promote expanded rights, including amnesty, for illegal aliens currently residing in the United States.
- [Catalist](#): This is a for-profit political consultancy that seeks “to help progressive organizations realize measurable increases in civic participation and electoral success by building and operating a robust national voter database of every voting-age American.”
- [Catholics for Choice](#): This nominally Catholic organization supports women’s right to abortion-on-demand.
- [Catholics in Alliance for the Common Good](#): This political nonprofit group is dedicated to generating support from the Catholic community for leftwing candidates, causes, and legislation.
- [Center for American Progress](#): This leftist think tank is headed by former [Clinton](#) chief of staff [John Podesta](#), works closely with [Hillary Clinton](#), and employs numerous former Clinton administration staffers. It is committed to “developing a long-term vision of a progressive America” and “providing a forum to generate new progressive ideas and policy proposals.”
- [Center for Community Change](#): This group recruits and trains activists to spearhead leftist “political issue campaigns.” Promoting increased funding for social welfare programs by bringing “attention to major national issues related to poverty,” the Center bases its training programs on the techniques taught by the famed radical organizer Saul Alinsky.
- [Center for Constitutional Rights](#): This pro-[Castro](#) organization is a core member of the [open borders lobby](#), has opposed virtually all post-9/11 anti-terrorism measures by the U.S. government, and alleges that American injustice provokes acts of international terrorism.
- [Center for Economic and Policy Research](#): This group opposed welfare reform, supports “living wage” laws, rejects tax cuts, and consistently lauds the professed achievements of socialist regimes, most notably Venezuela.

- [Center for International Policy](#): This organization uses advocacy, policy research, media outreach, and educational initiatives to promote “transparency and accountability” in U.S. foreign policy and global relations. It generally views America as a disruptive, negative force in the world.
- [Center for Reproductive Rights](#): CRR’s mission is to guarantee safe, affordable contraception and abortion-on-demand for all women, including adolescents. The organization has filed state and federal lawsuits demanding access to taxpayer-funded abortions (through Medicaid) for low-income women.
- [Center for Responsible Lending](#): This organization was a major player in the subprime mortgage crisis. According to Phil Kerpen (vice president for policy at Americans for Prosperity), CRL “sh[ook] down and harass[ed] banks into making bad loans to unqualified borrowers.” Moreover, CRL negotiated a contract enabling it to operate as a conduit of high-risk loans to Fannie Mae.
- [Center for Social Inclusion](#): This organization seeks to counteract America’s “structural racism” by means of taxpayer-funded policy initiatives.
- [Center on Budget and Policy Priorities](#): Reasoning from the premise that tax cuts generally help only the wealthy, this organization advocates greater tax expenditures on [social welfare programs](#) for low earners.
- [Center on Wisconsin Strategy \(COWS\)](#): Aiming to redistribute wealth by way of higher taxes imposed on those whose incomes are above average, COWS contends that “it is important that state government be able to harness fair contribution from all parts of society – including corporations and the wealthy.”
- [Change America Now](#): Formed in December 2006, Change America Now describes itself as “an independent political organization created to educate citizens on the failed policies of the Republican Congress and to contrast that record of failure with the promise offered by a Democratic agenda.”
- [Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington](#): This group litigates and brings ethics charges against “government officials who sacrifice the common good to special interests” and “betray the public trust.” Almost all of its targets are Republicans.
- Coalition for an [International Criminal Court](#): This group seeks to subordinate American criminal-justice procedures to those of an international court.
- [Color Of Change](#): This organization was founded to combat what it viewed as the systemic racism pervading America generally and conservatism in particular.
- [Common Cause](#): This organization aims to bring about campaign-finance reform, pursue media reform resembling the Fairness Doctrine, and cut military budgets in favor of increased social-welfare and environmental spending.
- [Constitution Project](#): This organization seeks to challenge the legality of military commissions; end the detainment of “enemy combatants”; condemn government surveillance of terrorists; and limit the President’s executive privileges.
- [Defenders of Wildlife](#) Action Fund: Defenders of Wildlife opposes oil exploration in Alaska’s Arctic National Wildlife Refuge. It condemns logging, ranching, mining, and even the use of recreational motorized vehicles as activities that are destructive to the environment.

- [Democracy Alliance](#): This self-described “liberal organization” aims to raise \$200 million to develop a funding clearinghouse for leftist groups. Soros is a major donor to this group.
- [Democracy 21](#): This group is a staunch supporter of the Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act of 2002, also known as the McCain-[Feingold](#) Act.
- [Democracy Now!](#): Democracy Now! was created in 1996 by WBAI radio news director Amy Goodman and four partners to provide “perspectives rarely heard in the U.S. corporate-sponsored media,” i.e., the views of radical and foreign journalists, left and labor activists, and ideological foes of capitalism.
- [Democratic Justice Fund](#): DJF opposes the Patriot Act and most efforts to restrict or regulate immigration into the United States — particularly from countries designated by the State Department as “terrorist nations.”
- [Democratic Party](#): Soros’ funding activities are devoted largely to helping the Democratic Party solidify its power base. In a November 2003 interview, Soros stated that defeating President Bush in 2004 “is the central focus of my life” ... “a matter of life and death.” He pledged to raise \$75 million to defeat Bush, and personally donated nearly a third of that amount to anti-Bush organizations. “America under Bush,” he said, “is a danger to the world, and I’m willing to put my money where my mouth is.”
- [Demos](#): This organization lobbies federal and state policymakers to “addres[s] the economic insecurity and inequality that characterize American society today”; promotes “ideas for reducing gaps in wealth, income and political influence”; and favors tax hikes for the wealthy.
- [Drum Major Institute](#): This group describes itself as “a non-partisan, non-profit think tank generating the ideas that fuel the progressive movement,” with the ultimate aim of persuading “policymakers and opinion-leaders” to take steps that advance its vision of “social and economic justice.”
- [Earthjustice](#): This group seeks to place severe restrictions on how U.S. land and waterways may be used. It opposes most mining and logging initiatives, commercial fishing businesses, and the use of motorized vehicles in undeveloped areas.
- [Economic Policy Institute](#): This organization believes that “government must play an active role in protecting the economically vulnerable, ensuring equal opportunity, and improving the well-being of all Americans.”
- [Electronic Privacy Information Center](#): This organization has been a harsh critic of the USA PATRIOT Act and has joined the American Civil Liberties Union in litigating two cases calling for the FBI “to publicly release or account for thousands of pages of information about the government’s use of PATRIOT Act powers.”
- [Ella Baker Center for Human Rights](#): Co-founded by the revolutionary communist Van Jones, this anti-poverty organization claims that “decades of disinvestment in our cities” — compounded by “excessive, racist policing and over-incarceration” — have “led to despair and homelessness.”
- [EMILY’s List](#): This political network raises money for Democratic female political candidates who support unrestricted access to [taxpayer-funded](#) abortion-on-demand.

- [Energy Action Coalition](#): Founded in 2004, this group describes itself as “a coalition of 50 youth-led environmental and social justice groups working together to build the youth clean energy and climate movement.” For EAC, this means “dismantling oppression” according to its principles of environmental justice.
- [Equal Justice USA](#): This group claims that America’s criminal-justice system is plagued by “significant race and class biases,” and thus seeks to promote major reforms.
- [Fair Immigration Reform Movement](#): This is the open-borders arm of the Center for Community Change.
- [Faithful America](#): This organization promotes the redistribution of wealth, an end to enhanced interrogation procedures vis a vis prisoners-of-war, the enactment of policies to combat global warming, and the creation of a government-run health care system.
- [Families USA](#): This Washington-based health-care advocacy group favors ever-increasing government control of the American healthcare system.
- [Feminist Majority](#): Characterizing the United States as an inherently sexist nation, this group focuses on “advancing the legal, social and political equality of women with men, countering the backlash to women’s advancement, and recruiting and training young feminists to encourage future leadership for the feminist movement in the United States.”
- [Four Freedoms Fund](#): This organization was designed to serve as a conduit through which large foundations could fund state-based open-borders organizations more flexibly and quickly.
- [Free Exchange on Campus](#): This organization was created solely to oppose the efforts of one individual, David Horowitz, and his campaign to have universities adopt an “[Academic Bill of Rights](#),” as well as to [denounce](#) Horowitz’s 2006 book *The Professors*. Member organizations of FEC include [Campus Progress](#) (a project of the [Center for American Progress](#)); the [American Association of University Professors](#); the [American Civil Liberties Union](#); [People For the American Way](#); the [United States Student Association](#); the [Center for Campus Free Speech](#); the [American Library Association](#); [Free Press](#); and the National Association of State [Public Interest Research Groups](#).
- [Free Press](#): This “media reform” organization has worked closely with many notable leftists and such organizations as [Media Matters for America](#), [Air America Radio](#), [Global Exchange](#), [Code Pink](#), [Fairness and Accuracy in Reporting](#), the [Revolutionary Communist Party](#), [Mother Jones](#) magazine, and [Pacifica Radio](#).
- [Funding Exchange](#): Dedicated to the concept of philanthropy as a vehicle for social change, this organization pairs leftist donors and foundations with likeminded groups and activists who are dedicated to bringing about their own version of “progressive” change and [social justice](#). Many of these grantees assume that American society is rife with racism, discrimination, exploitation, and inequity and needs to be overhauled via sustained education, activism, and social agitation.
- [Gamaliel Foundation](#): Modeling its tactics on those of the radical Sixties activist Saul Alinsky, this group takes a strong stand against current homeland security measures and immigration restrictions.

- [Gisha: Center for the Legal Protection of Freedom of Movement](#): This anti-Israel organization seeks to help Palestinians “exercise their right to freedom of movement.”
- [Global Centre for the Responsibility to Protect](#): This group contends that when a state proves either unable or unwilling to protect civilians from mass atrocities occurring within its borders, it is the responsibility of the international community to intervene — peacefully if possible, but with military force if necessary.
- [Global Exchange](#): Established in 1988 by pro-Castro radical [Medea Benjamin](#), this group consistently condemns America’s foreign policy, business practices, and domestic life. Following the 9/11 terrorist attacks, Global Exchange advised Americans to examine “the root causes of resentment against the United States in the Arab world — from our dependence on Middle Eastern oil to our biased policy towards Israel.”
- [Grantmakers Without Borders](#): GWB tends to be very supportive of leftist environmental, anti-war, and civil rights groups. It is also generally hostile to capitalism, which it deems one of the chief “political, economic, and social systems” that give rise to a host of “social ills.”
- [Green For All](#): This group was created by [Van Jones](#) to lobby for federal climate, energy, and economic policy initiatives.
- [Health Care for America Now](#): This group supports a “single payer” model where the federal government would be in charge of financing and administering the entire U.S. healthcare system.
- [Human Rights Campaign](#): The largest “lesbian-gay-bisexual-transgender” lobbying group in the United States, HRC supports political candidates and legislation that will advance the LGBT agenda. Historically, HRC has most vigorously championed HIV/AIDS-related legislation, “hate crime” laws, the abrogation of the military’s “Don’t Ask, Don’t Tell” policy, and the legalization of gay marriage.
- [Human Rights First](#): This group supports open borders and the rights of illegal aliens; charges that the Patriot Act severely erodes Americans’ civil liberties; has filed *amicus curiae* briefs on behalf of terror suspect [Jose Padilla](#); and deplores the Guantanamo Bay detention facilities.
- [Human Rights Watch](#): This group directs a disproportionate share of its criticism at the United States and Israel. It opposes the death penalty in all cases, and supports open borders and amnesty for illegal aliens.
- [I’lam](#): This anti-Israel NGO seeks “to develop and empower the Arab media and to give voice to Palestinian issues.”
- [Immigrant Defense Project](#): To advance the cause of illegal immigrants, the IDP provides immigration law backup support and counseling to New York defense attorneys and others who represent or assist immigrants in criminal justice and immigration systems, as well as to immigrants themselves.
- [Immigrant Legal Resource Center](#): This group claims to have helped gain amnesty for some three million illegal aliens in the U.S., and in the 1980s was part of the sanctuary movement which sought to grant asylum to refugees from the failed Communist states of Central America.
- [Immigrant Workers Citizenship Project](#): This open-borders organization advocates mass immigration to the U.S.

- [Immigration Advocates Network](#): This alliance of immigrant-rights groups seeks to “increase access to justice for low-income immigrants and strengthen the capacity of organizations serving them.”
- [Immigration Policy Center](#): IPC is an advocate of open borders and contends that the massive influx of illegal immigrants into America is due to U.S. government policy, since “the broken immigration system [...] spurs unauthorized immigration in the first place.”
- [Independent Media Center](#): This Internet-based, news and events bulletin board represents an invariably leftist, anti-capitalist perspective and serves as a mouthpiece for anti-globalization/anti-America themes.
- [Independent Media Institute](#): IMI administers the SPIN Project (Strategic Press Information Network), which provides leftist organizations with “accessible and affordable strategic communications consulting, training, coaching, networking opportunities and concrete tools” to help them “achieve their social justice goals.”
- [Institute for America’s Future](#): IAF supports socialized medicine, increased government funding for education, and the creation of an infrastructure “to ensure that the voice of the progressive majority is heard.”
- [Institute for New Economic Thinking](#): Seeking to create a new worldwide “economic paradigm,” this organization is staffed by numerous individuals who favor government intervention in national economies, and who view capitalism as a flawed system.
- [Institute for Policy Studies](#): This think tank has long supported Communist and anti-American causes around the world. Viewing capitalism as a breeding ground for “unrestrained greed,” IPS seeks to provide a corrective to “unrestrained markets and individualism.” Professing an unquestioning faith in the righteousness of the United Nations, it aims to bring American foreign policy under UN control.
- [Institute for Public Accuracy](#): This anti-American, anti-capitalist organization sponsored actor Sean Penn’s celebrated visit to Baghdad in 2002. It also sponsored visits to Iraq by Democratic Congressmen Nick Rahall and former Democrat Senator James Abourezk
- [Institute for Women’s Policy Research](#): This group views the U.S. as a nation rife with discrimination against women, and publishes research to draw attention to this alleged state of affairs. It also advocates unrestricted access to taxpayer-funded abortion-on-demand, stating that “access to abortion is essential to the economic well-being of women and girls.”
- [International Crisis Group](#): One of this organization’s leading figures is its Mideast Director, Robert Malley, who was President Bill Clinton’s Special Assistant for Arab-Israeli Affairs. His analysis of the Mideast conflict is markedly pro-Palestinian.
- [J Street](#): This anti-Israel group warns that Israel’s choice to take military action to stop Hamas’ terrorist attacks “will prove counter-productive and only deepen the cycle of violence in the region”
- [Jewish Funds for Justice](#): This organization views government intervention and taxpayer funding as crucial components of enlightened social policy. It seeks to redistribute wealth from Jewish donors to low-income communities “to combat the root causes of domestic economic and social injustice.” By JFJ’s reckoning, chief

among those root causes are the inherently negative by-products of capitalism – most notably racism and “gross economic inequality.”

- [Joint Victory Campaign 2004](#): Founded by George Soros and [Harold Ickes](#), this group was a major fundraising entity for Democrats during the 2004 election cycle. It collected contributions (including large amounts from Soros personally) and disbursed them to two other groups, [America Coming Together](#) and the [Media Fund](#), which also worked on behalf of Democrats.
- [Justice at Stake](#): This coalition calls for judges to be appointed by nonpartisan, independent commissions in a process known as “merit selection,” rather than elected by the voting public.
- [LatinoJustice PRLDF](#): This organization supports bilingual education, the racial gerrymandering of voting districts, and expanded rights for illegal aliens.
- [Lawyers Committee for Civil Rights Under Law](#): This group views America as an unremittingly racist nation; uses the courts to mandate race-based affirmative action preferences in business and academia; has filed briefs against the Department of Homeland Security’s efforts to limit the wholesale granting of green cards and to identify potential terrorists; condemns the Patriot Act; and calls on Americans to “recognize the contribution” of illegal aliens.
- [Leadership Conference on Civil and Human Rights](#): This organization views the United States as a nation rife with racism, sexism, and all manner of social injustice; and it uses legislative advocacy to push for “progressive change” that will create “a more open and just society.”
- [League of United Latin American Citizens](#): This group views America as a nation plagued by “an alarming increase in xenophobia and anti-Hispanic sentiment”; favors racial preferences; supports the legalization of illegal Hispanic aliens; opposes military surveillance of U.S. borders; opposes making English America’s official language; favors open borders; and rejects anti-terrorism legislation like the Patriot Act.
- [League of Women Voters Education Fund](#): The League supports taxpayer-funded abortion-on-demand; supports “motor-voter” registration, which allows anyone with a driver’s license to become a voter, regardless of citizenship status; and supports tax hikes and socialized medicine.
- [League of Young Voters](#): This organization seeks to “empowe[r] young people nationwide” to “participate in the democratic process and create progressive political change on the local, state and national level[s].”
- [Lynne Stewart Defense Committee](#): IRS records indicate that Soros’s Open Society Institute made a September 2002 grant of \$20,000 to this organization. Stewart was the criminal-defense attorney who was later convicted for abetting her client, the “blind sheik” [Omar Abdel Rahman](#), in terrorist activities connected with his [Islamic Group](#).
- [Machsom Watch](#): This organization [describes](#) itself as “a movement of Israeli women, peace activists from all sectors of Israeli society, who oppose the Israeli occupation and the denial of Palestinians’ rights to move freely in their land.”
- [MADRE](#): This international women’s organization deems America the world’s foremost violator of human rights. As such, it seeks to “communicate[]” the real-life

impact of U.S. policies on women and families confronting violence, poverty and repression around the world,” and to “demand alternatives to destructive U.S. policies.” It also advocates unrestricted access to taxpayer-funded abortion-on-demand.

- [Malcolm X Grassroots Movement](#): This group views the U.S. as a nation replete with racism and discrimination against blacks; seeks to establish an independent black nation in the southeastern United States; and demands reparations for slavery.
- [Massachusetts Immigrant and Refugee Advocacy Coalition](#): This group calls for the expansion of civil rights and liberties for illegal aliens; laments that illegal aliens in America are commonly subjected to “worker exploitation”; supports tuition-assistance programs for illegal aliens attending college; and characterizes the Patriot Act as a “very troubling” assault on civil liberties.
- [Media Fund](#): Soros played a major role in creating this group, whose purpose was to conceptualize, produce, and place political ads on television, radio, print, and the Internet.
- [Media Matters for America](#): This organization is a “web-based, not-for-profit ... progressive research and information center” seeking to “systematically monitor a cross-section of print, broadcast, cable, radio, and Internet media outlets for conservative misinformation.” The group works closely with the Soros-backed [Center for American Progress](#), and is heavily funded by [Democracy Alliance](#), of which Soros is a major financier.
- [Mercy Corps](#): Vis a vis the Arab-Israeli conflict, Mercy Corps places all blame for Palestinian poverty and suffering directly on Israel.
- [Mexican American Legal Defense and Education Fund](#): This group advocates open borders, free college tuition for illegal aliens, lowered educational standards to accommodate Hispanics, and voting rights for criminals. In MALDEF’s view, supporters of making English the official language of the United States are “motivated by racism and anti-immigrant sentiments,” while advocates of sanctions against employers reliant on illegal labor seek to discriminate against “brown-skinned people.”
- [Meyer, Suozzi, English and Klein, PC](#): This influential defender of Big Labor is headed by Democrat operative [Harold Ickes](#).
- [Midwest Academy](#): This entity trains radical activists in the tactics of direct action, targeting, confrontation, and intimidation.
- [Migration Policy Institute](#): This group seeks to create “a North America with gradually disappearing border controls ... with permanent migration remaining at moderate levels.”
- [Military Families Speak Out](#): This group ascribes the U.S. invasion of Iraq to American imperialism and lust for oil.
- [Missourians Organizing for Reform and Empowerment](#): This group is the rebranded Missouri branch of the now-defunct, pro-socialist, community organization ACORN.
- [MoveOn.org](#): This Web-based organization supports Democratic political candidates through fundraising, advertising, and get-out-the-vote drives.
- [Ms. Foundation for Women](#): This group laments what it views as the widespread and enduring flaws of American society: racism, sexism, homophobia, and the violation of

civil rights and liberties. It focuses its philanthropy on groups that promote affirmative action for women, unfettered access to taxpayer-funded abortion-on-demand, amnesty for illegal aliens, and big government generally.

- [Muslim Advocates](#): [Opposed](#) to U.S. counter-terrorism strategies that make use of sting operations and informants, MA characterizes such tactics as forms of “entrapment” that are inherently discriminatory against Muslims.
- [NARAL Pro-Choice America](#): This group supports taxpayer-funded abortion-on-demand, and works to elect pro-abortion Democrats.
- [NAACP](#) Legal Defense and Education Fund: The NAACP supports racial preferences in employment and education, as well as the racial gerrymandering of voting districts. Underpinning its support for race preferences is the fervent belief that white racism in the United States remains an intractable, largely undiminished, phenomenon.
- The [Nation Institute](#): This nonprofit entity sponsors leftist conferences, fellowships, awards for radical activists, and journalism internships.

It overwhelmingly promotes grant-makers and grantees with leftist agendas, while criticizing their conservative counterparts.
- [National Committee for Voting Integrity](#): This group opposes “the implementation of proof of citizenship and photo identification requirements for eligible electors in American elections as the means of assuring election integrity.”

Some of those products included Back to Nature Classic Granola, Nature Valley Granola Protein Oats 'n Honey, Quaker Dinosaur Egg Instant Oats, Great Value Original Instant Oatmeal, Cheerios Toasted Whole Grain Oat Cereal, Lucky Charms, Quaker Steel Cut Oats and Kellogg's Nutrigrain Strawberry Breakfast Bars.

Some of America's most popular breakfast foods come with a 'hefty dose' of Monsanto's weed-killing chemical Glyphosate, according to a report by the Environmental Working Group (EWG).

Monsanto is one of the most-evil corporations ever to appear in human history. They create products that are unbelievably destructive to the human body, and do it all in the name of profit. Monsanto's Roundup weed-killer contains a killer chemical called glyphosate, and when ingested in large amounts cause cancer. Recent tests show it is in the breakfast cereal you are likely feeding to your family right now. They produced "agent orange" used in Viet Nam to defoliate the jungles, which led to air crew members spraying the jungle of Viet Nam, to in turn develop cancer. Monsanto denied being the cause of U.S. Army service personnel that

came down with cancer and for decades denied their product killed American military troops. Glyphosate was the main ingredient of “agent orange” used in the Viet Nam War.

Interestingly, glyphosate was not found in any of the organic cereals tested.

The non-profit published the results Wednesday morning from independent lab tests it commissioned on dozens of products made with oats. The tests found traces of glyphosate, the active chemical ingredient in Monsanto’s Roundup weed killer, in all but two of the 45 products it tested that were made with conventionally grown oats.

Additionally the EWG said 31 of the 45 samples it tested had glyphosate levels higher than what its scientists consider “protective of children’s health.” Some of those products included Back to Nature Classic Granola, Nature Valley Granola Protein Oats ‘n Honey, Quaker Dinosaur Egg Instant Oats, Great Value Original Instant Oatmeal, Cheerios Toasted Whole Grain Oat Cereal, Lucky Charms, Quaker Steel Cut Oats and Kellogg’s Nutrigrain Strawberry Breakfast Bars.

However, the levels that EWG considers to be high doesn’t violate the legal limit set by the Environmental Protection Agency. This is another example of where a governmental agency rated legal limits as acceptable, when the fact is cancer can be caused with cumulative amounts of Glyphosate. I have known this as a medical fact since 2007.

“I grew up eating Cheerios and Quaker Oats oatmeal long before they were tainted with glyphosate,” said EWG President Ken Cook. *“No one wants to eat a weed killer for breakfast, and no one should have to do so.”*

Cook added that they plan to petition the EPA to end uses of glyphosate that resulted in the contamination results the testing uncovered.

In a statement provided to CBS News, Monsanto pushed back against the study’s results saying that “even at the highest level reported... an adult would have to eat 118 pounds of the food item every day for the rest of their life in order to reach the EPA’s limit ”for glyphosate residues.”

Why did the EPA increase the safety level of glyphosate in the food supply? The government and Big Food industry likes to fall back on the government’s “safety limits” but what they aren’t telling you is that **the EPA increased the safety limit of glyphosate in food!**

“The EPA likely saw it was increasingly being used as a pre-harvest [desiccant] and increased the limit to allow it to be legal,” said Dr. Alexis Temkin, a toxicologist at the EWG and one of the authors of the report to *‘Daily Mail’*.

“...the EPA increased the amounts of glyphosate residue allowed on oats from 20 ppm in 1997 to 30 ppm in 2008,” Temkin added. The Environmental Working Group is demanding that glyphosate levels be under 160 parts per billion.

Most people don't know that glyphosate has been linked to **breast cancer at parts per TRILLION**. Let's try to wrap our heads around that number for a second... This stuff is sprayed in our parks and school grounds! We track it into our houses on our shoes when we walk through parking lots. Farmers spray it in their fields sometimes several times a year.

A judge recently upheld a case where Glyphosate, but reduced the settlement to a dying man to \$17-million dollars, from a jury award of several hundred million dollars.

No fewer than 15 health problems are linked to Monsanto's Roundup[®]

Monsanto invented the herbicide glyphosate and brought it to market under the trade name Roundup in 1974, after DDT was banned. But it wasn't until the late 1990s that the use of Roundup surged, thanks to Monsanto's ingenious marketing strategy. The strategy? Genetically engineer seeds to grow food crops that could tolerate high doses of Roundup! With the introduction of these new GE seeds, farmers could now easily control weeds on their corn, soy, cotton, canola, sugar beets and alfalfa crops—crops that thrived while the weeds around them were wiped out by Roundup.

In the nearly 20 years of intensifying exposure, scientists have been documenting the health consequences of Roundup and glyphosate in our food, in the water we drink, in the air we breathe and where our children play.

Eager to sell more of its flagship herbicide, Monsanto also encouraged farmers to use Roundup as a desiccant, to dry out all of their crops so they could harvest them faster. So

Roundup is now routinely sprayed directly on a host of non-GMO crops, including wheat, barley, oats, canola, flax, peas, lentils, soybeans, dry beans and sugar cane.

Between 1996 - 2011, the widespread use of Roundup Ready GMO crops increased herbicide use in the U.S. by 527 million pounds—even though Monsanto claimed its GMO crops would reduce pesticide and herbicide use.

Monsanto has falsified data on Roundup's safety, and marketed it to parks departments and consumers as “environmentally friendly” and “biodegradable”, to encourage its use it had on roadsides, playgrounds, golf courses, schoolyards, lawns and home gardens. A French court ruled those marketing claims amounted to false advertising.

In the nearly 20 years of intensifying exposure, scientists have been documenting the health consequences of Roundup and glyphosate in our food, in the water we drink, in the air we breathe and where our children play.

They've found that people who are sick have higher levels of glyphosate in their bodies than healthy people. They've also found the following health problems which they attribute to exposure to Roundup and/or glyphosate:

ADHD: In farming communities, there's a strong correlation between Roundup exposure and attention deficit disorder (ADHD), likely due to glyphosate's capacity to disrupt thyroid hormone functions.

Alzheimer's disease: In the lab, Roundup causes the same type of oxidative stress and neural cell death observed in Alzheimer's disease. And it affects CaMKII, an enzyme whose dysregulation has also been linked to the disease.

Anencephaly (birth defect): An investigation into neural tube defects among babies born to women living within 1,000 meters of pesticide applications showed an association for glyphosate with anencephaly, the absence of a major portion of the brain, skull and scalp that forms during embryonic development.

Autism: Glyphosate has a number of known biological effects that align with the known pathologies associated with autism. One of these parallels is the gut dysbiosis observed in autistic children and the toxicity of glyphosate to beneficial bacteria that suppress pathogenic bacteria, along with pathogenic bacteria's high resistance to glyphosate. In addition, glyphosate's capacity to promote aluminum accumulation in the brain may make it the principal cause of autism in the U.S.

Birth defects: Roundup and glyphosate can disrupt the Vitamin A (retinoic acid) signaling pathway, which is crucial for normal fetal development. The babies of women living within one kilometer of fields sprayed with glyphosate were more than twice as likely to have birth defects according to a study from Paraguay. Congenital defects quadrupled in the decade after

Roundup Ready crops arrived in Chaco, a province in Argentina where glyphosate is used roughly eight to ten times more per acre than in the U.S. A study of one farming family in the U.S. documented elevated levels of glyphosate and birth defects in the children, including an imperforate anus, growth hormone deficiency, hypospadias (an abnormally placed urinary hole), a heart defect and a micro penis.

Brain cancer: In a study of children with brain cancer compared with healthy children, researchers found that if either parent had been exposed to Roundup during the two years before the child's birth, the chances of the child developing brain cancer doubled.

Breast cancer: Glyphosate induces human breast cancer cells growth via estrogen receptors. The only long-term animal study of glyphosate exposure produced rats with mammary tumors and shortened life-spans.

Cancer: House-to-house surveys of 65,000 people in farming communities in Argentina where Roundup is used, known there as the fumigated towns, found cancer rates two to four times higher than the national average, with increases in breast, prostate and lung cancers. In a comparison of two villages, in the one where Roundup was sprayed, 31 percent of residents had a family member with cancer, while only 3 percent of residents in a ranching village without spraying had one. The high cancer rates among people exposed to Roundup likely stem from glyphosate's known capacity to induce DNA damage, which has been demonstrated in numerous lab tests.

Celiac disease and gluten intolerance: Fish exposed to glyphosate develop digestive problems that are reminiscent of celiac disease. There are parallels between the characteristics of celiac disease and the known effects of glyphosate. These include imbalances in gut bacteria, impairment in enzymes involved with detoxifying environmental toxins, mineral deficiencies and amino acid depletion.

Chronic kidney disease: Increases in the use of glyphosate may explain the recent surge in kidney failure among agricultural workers in Central America, Sri Lanka and India. Scientists have concluded, "Although glyphosate alone does not cause an epidemic of chronic kidney disease, it seems to have acquired the ability to destroy the renal tissues of thousands of farmers when it forms complexes with [hard water] and nephrotoxic metals."

Colitis: The toxicity of glyphosate to beneficial bacteria that suppress clostridia, along with clostridia's high resistance to glyphosate, could be a significant predisposing factor in the overgrowth of clostridia. Overgrowth of clostridia, specifically *C. difficile*, is a well-established causal factor in colitis.

Depression: Glyphosate disrupts chemical processes that impact the production of serotonin, an important neurotransmitter that regulates mood, appetite and sleep. Serotonin impairment has been linked to depression.

Diabetes: Low levels of testosterone are a risk factor for Type 2 diabetes. Rats fed environmentally relevant doses of Roundup over a period of 30 days spanning the onset of puberty had reduced testosterone production sufficient to alter testicular cell morphology and to delay the onset of puberty.

Heart disease: Glyphosate can disrupt the body's enzymes, causing lysosomal dysfunction, a major factor in cardiovascular disease and heart failure.

Hypothyroidism: House-to-house surveys of 65,000 people in farming communities in Argentina where Roundup is used, known there as the fumigated towns, found higher rates of hypothyroidism.

Inflammatory Bowel Disease ("Leaky Gut Syndrome"): Glyphosate can induce severe tryptophan deficiency, which can lead to an extreme inflammatory bowel disease that severely impairs the ability to absorb nutrients through the gut, due to inflammation, bleeding and diarrhea.

Liver disease: Very low doses of Roundup can disrupt human liver cell function, according to a 2009 study published in the journal *'Toxicology'*.

Lou Gehrig's Disease (ALS): Sulfate deficiency in the brain has been associated with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS). Glyphosate disrupts sulfate transport from the gut to the liver, and may lead over time to severe sulfate deficiency throughout all the tissues, including the brain.

Multiple Sclerosis (MS): An increased incidence of inflammatory bowel disease (IBS) has been found in association with MS. Glyphosate may be a causal factor. The hypothesis is that glyphosate-induced IBS causes gut bacteria to leak into the vasculature, triggering an immune reaction and consequently an autoimmune disorder resulting in destruction of the myelin sheath.

Non-Hodgkin lymphoma: A systematic review and a series of meta-analyses of nearly three decades worth of epidemiologic research on the relationship between non-Hodgkin lymphoma (NHL) and occupational exposure to agricultural pesticides found that B-cell lymphoma was positively associated with glyphosate.

Parkinson's disease: The brain-damaging effects of herbicides have been recognized as the main environmental factor associated with neurodegenerative disorders, including Parkinson's disease. The onset of Parkinson's following exposure to glyphosate has been well-documented and lab studies show that glyphosate induces the cell death characteristic of the disease.

Pregnancy problems (infertility, miscarriages, stillbirths): Glyphosate is toxic to human placental cells, which, scientists say, explains the pregnancy problems of agricultural workers

exposed to the herbicide. It is being studied as the potential cause of infertility in men where sperm rates have been reduced by half.

Obesity: An experiment involving the transfer of a strain of endotoxin-producing bacteria from the gut of an obese human to the guts of mice caused the mice to become obese. Since glyphosate induces a shift in gut bacteria towards endotoxin-producers, glyphosate exposure may contribute to obesity in this way.

Reproductive problems: Studies of laboratory animals have found that male rats exposed to high levels of glyphosate, either during prenatal or pubertal development, suffer from reproductive problems, including delayed puberty, decreased sperm production, and decreased testosterone production.

Respiratory illnesses: House-to-house surveys of 65,000 people in farming communities in Argentina where Roundup is used, known there as the fumigated towns, found higher rates of chronic respiratory illnesses.

(Natural News) Court documents released on March 13th show that Monsanto colluded with the EPA to bury scientific evidence linking its glyphosate product (RoundUp) to cancer in humans (specifically, Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma).

In this phase, which is limited to "general causation," the Court will decide only whether there is sufficient admissible evidence that glyphosate and/or Roundup is capable of causing cancer (specifically, Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma) in humans.

Texas A&M's motion to quash the subpoena to Dr. Ivan Rusyn is granted. [Who is Dr. Ivan Rusyn? And why doesn't Monsanto want him subpoenaed?]

Monsanto's request to seal the documents submitted in connection with the motion to compel Rowland's deposition is denied, with the exception of one document. As previously mentioned, the EPA reports are important to this litigation. Therefore, to support its sealing request, Monsanto must present compelling reasons for concealing documents relating to the EPA reports from the public... Potential embarrassment to Monsanto (or to Jess Rowland) is not enough.

Finally, the parties have submitted a discovery letter regarding Monsanto's practice of designating a high percentage of documents produced in discovery as "confidential" in accordance with the protective order. That dispute is resolved in favor of Monsanto... when the plaintiffs provisionally file documents under seal based on Monsanto's confidentiality designation, Monsanto must undertake a good-faith review of the documents and inform the Court whether they should remain under seal. [i.e. Monsanto will inform the court of whether Monsanto thinks its own documents should remain secret from the court.]

If Monsanto continues to file unreasonable or unsubstantiated declarations, it will be sanctioned.

Does Glyphosate / RoundUp cause Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma?

Here's what a few authors and researchers say on the subject: Because the shikimate pathway is only found in plants, it is assumed that glyphosate does not affect animals and therefore is safe; however, the retinoic acid signaling pathway in animals is very similar to the shikimate pathway. Research by Mesnage et al. found that Roundup from 1 ppm to 20,000 ppm causes cells of the human body to die through necrosis. At 50 ppm it delays the cellular apoptosis that is essential for the normal functioning and regeneration of cells, body tissues, and organs. GLYPHOSATE AND CANCERS: A case-controlled study published in March 1999 by Swedish scientists Lennart Hardell and Mikael Eriksson showed that non-hodgkin's lymphoma (NHL) is linked to exposure to a range of pesticides and herbicides, including glyphosate. Prior to the 1940s, non-hodgkin's lymphoma was one of the world's rarest cancers. Now it is one of the most common. Between 1973 and 1991, the incidence of non-hodgkin's lymphoma increased at the rate of 3.3 percent per year in the United States, making it the third fastest-growing cancer. In Sweden, the incidence of NHL has increased at the rate of 3.6 percent per year in men and 2.9 percent per year in women since 1958.— The Myths of Safe Pesticides by Andre Leu.

Roundup[®] Ready soybeans convert much of the applied glyphosate into a metabolite called AMPA (aminomethylphosphonic acid) with unknown health properties. In one study, the beans contained 3 mg/kg of glyphosate and up to 25 mg/kg of AMPA.³⁵ "The presence of high AMPA residues in Roundup Ready soybean was not anticipated and presents a new type of consumer exposure." Glyphosate is toxic According to the Journal of Pesticide Reform, "Symptoms of exposure to glyphosate include eye irritation, burning eyes, blurred vision, skin rashes, burning or itchy skin, nausea, sore throat, asthma and difficulty breathing, headache, lethargy, nose bleeds, and dizziness. Glyphosate and glyphosate-containing herbicides caused genetic damage in laboratory tests with human cells, as well as in tests with laboratory animals. ... Exposure is linked with increased risks of the cancer non-hodgkin's lymphoma, miscarriages, and attention deficit disorder," as well as Parkinson's disease. Exposure to mouse testicular cells (Leydig cells) resulted in a 94% reduction in sex hormone production.

According to French and international bodies, glyphosate is considered an irritant that may produce severe eye lesions, and [is] toxic for aquatic organisms,” Marc reports. “According to the World Health Organization, the U.S. EPA, and the European Community, the use of glyphosate in accordance with the manufacturers’ instructions therefore poses no human health risks. . . . However, several epidemiological studies have demonstrated a correlation between exposure to glyphosate and cancer.” Roundup Triggers the First Stage of the Development of Cancer: In fact, while regulatory agencies have continued to classify glyphosate-based herbicides as “not a human carcinogen,” a series of epidemiological studies tend to demonstrate exactly the opposite. For example, a Canadian study published in 2001 by the University of Saskatchewan showed that men exposed to glyphosate more than two days a year had twice the risk of developing non-hodgkin’s lymphoma of men never exposed.

Back in 2015, the American Liver Foundation estimated that at least one in four Americans was living with non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD), an illness that can affect even those who drink little or no alcohol. People in their 40s and 50s are most vulnerable, especially those who carry extra weight around their bellies.

But while maintaining a healthy weight and taking other reasonable precautions to optimize health, including eating a nutrient-dense diet and getting regular exercise, are important ways to prevent this disease, a recent study found that chronic exposure to even very low doses of Monsanto’s Roundup herbicide can also be linked to the development of NAFLD.

Animal trials prove conclusive link. The study, conducted by a research team from King’s College London and published in the journal *Scientific Reports*, concluded:

“Chronic consumption of extremely low levels of a GBH formulation (Roundup), at admissible glyphosate-equivalent concentrations, are associated with marked alterations of the liver proteome and metabolome. These changes in molecular profile overlap substantially with biomarkers of NAFLD and its progression to NASH [Nonalcoholic steatohepatitis.]”

The research team reached this conclusion after exposing two groups of 10 Harlan Sprague-Dawley rats to exactly the same environmental conditions for a two-year period, with the control group receiving plain water each day, while the test group was given water supplemented with 1.1% of Roundup.

‘Natural Health 365’ reported: [The study] used cutting-edge analytical methods such as protein composition profile and small molecule metabolite biochemical profile.

These techniques showed biomarkers of NAFLD and its progression to steatohepatitis – a more advanced form of fatty liver disease – and confirmed liver dysfunction, as well as cell damage from oxidative stress. Roundup-treated female rats showed 3 times more anatomical signs of pathology than rats in the control group.

As noted by ‘*Natural Health 365*’, the dosage of Roundup used in the study was a whopping 437,000 times lower than the levels permitted in American tap water. This was the first study to look at the effects of exposure to such low doses of the herbicide; previous studies only looked at the effects of mega-doses.

The researchers called these results “very worrying” and led them to push for new guidelines regarding the safety of glyphosate-based herbicides.

What is NAFLD?

The liver, an organ which performs many important functions in the body, is normally comprised of approximately 5 to 10 percent fat. NAFLD is diagnosed when the amount of fat in the liver exceeds this number in patients who do not partake of excessive amounts of alcohol. Certain forms of the disease can cause liver inflammation and ultimately result in irreversible damage that can lead to cirrhosis and even liver failure.

While many NAFLD patients present a similar profile in terms of being overweight (particularly carrying excess weight around their bellies), being sedentary, eating a high-sugar, processed diet, and being diabetic, researchers have been baffled by the number of people who develop NAFLD despite not presenting with these risk factors. The latest study might finally have solved the problem.

U.S. foods are swimming in Roundup

Close to 300 million pounds of Roundup are applied to U.S. crops each year, making it the most used agricultural chemical in the history of the world. This is seriously disturbing, because in addition to its clear links to NAFLD, multiple studies have linked it to the development of cancer, and in 2015 the World Health Organization’s *International Agency for Research on Cancer* (IARC) classified it as “probably carcinogenic to humans (Group 2A).”

Most of the public lives in ignorance or denial when it comes to Roundup. Each of the disorders in this list has been under study for at least fifteen years. Farmers, farm co-ops, and

particularly organic farms have met stiff resistance by Monsanto for the past three decades, if not longer. Monsanto employs one of the largest group of litigation attorneys in the industry to stonewall the farming community on health and crop matters.

The Australian documentary, “The Monsanto Papers,” reveals the secret tactics used by global chemical giant Monsanto (now owned by Bayer AG), to protect its bestselling herbicide, Roundup.

The film starts out with a quick history of Roundup and how its now-clearly absurd safety claims (such as “it’s biodegradable,” “safe enough to drink,” and “safer than table salt”) made it into the worlds’ most widely used weed killer, used by farmers and private gardeners alike. Indeed, it was at one time known as “the world’s most trusted herbicide,” but those days are now long gone.

Between 1974 — the year glyphosate entered the U.S. market — and 2014, glyphosate use increased more than 250-fold in the U.S. Today, an estimated 300 million pounds are applied on U.S. farmland annually. Globally, nearly 5 billion pounds (over 2 billion kilograms) of glyphosate are applied to some 70 types of farm crops each year.

Mounting evidence suggests Roundup is far from harmless, and evidence unearthed during legal discovery shows Monsanto has been well aware of its product’s toxic nature, and has been covering it up.

As previously discussed in many articles, glyphosate and glyphosate-based weed killer formulations such as Roundup have in recent years been linked to a wide variety of human health consequences, including:

Non-Hodgkin lymphoma

Impairing your body’s ability to produce fully functioning proteins

Inhibiting the shikimate pathway (found in gut bacteria)

Interfering with the function of cytochrome P450 enzymes, required for activation of vitamin D and the creation of nitric oxide

Chelating important mineral

Disrupting sulfate synthesis and transport

Interfering with the synthesis of aromatic amino acids and methionine, resulting in folate and

neurotransmitter shortages

Disrupting your microbiome by acting as an antibiotic

Impairing methylation pathways

Inhibiting pituitary release of thyroid stimulating hormone, which can lead to hypothyroidism

Monsanto Papers Reveal Company’s Efforts to Squash Evidence of Carcinogenicity. On August 10, 2018, a jury ruled in favor of plaintiff Dewayne Johnson in a truly historic case against Monsanto. Johnson — the first of 9,000 pending legal cases — claimed Monsanto’s Roundup caused his Non-Hodgkin lymphoma.

Forty-six-year-old Johnson sprayed about 150 gallons of Roundup 20 to 40 times per year while working as a groundskeeper for the Benicia school district in California, from 2012 through late 2015. His lawsuit, filed in 2016 after he became too ill to work, accused Monsanto of hiding the health hazards of Roundup.

According to the ruling, Monsanto “acted with malice or oppression” and was responsible for “negligent failure” by not warning consumers about the carcinogenicity of this pernicious weed killer. His court case, presided by Superior Court Judge Suzanne Ramos Bolanos, began June 18, 2018, and ended August 10 with a ruling in his favor.

The jury ordered Monsanto to pay \$289 million in damages to Johnson — an amount that effectively wipes out Monsanto’s reserve fund for environmental and litigation liability which, according to Bloomberg, totaled \$277 million as of August 2018. On appeal, the judge reduced the settlement to \$17-million dollars.

The evidence presented to the jury, including email correspondence and corporate documents, create a comprehensive narrative of corporate malfeasance and collusion with U.S. regulatory agencies, and it was this evidence that ultimately led to Johnson being awarded a quarter of a billion dollars in damages.

In “The Monsanto Papers: Poisoning the Scientific Well,” a paper published in *“The International Journal of Risk & Safety in Medicine”*, June 2018, Leemon McHenry describes the importance of this cache of documents:

“The documents reveal Monsanto-sponsored ghostwriting of articles published in toxicology journals and the lay media, interference in the peer review process, behind-the-scenes influence on retraction and the creation of a so-called academic website as a front for the defense of Monsanto products ... The use of third-party academics in the corporate defense of glyphosate reveals that this practice extends beyond the corruption of medicine and persists in spite of efforts to enforce transparency in industry manipulation.”

Following Johnson’s verdict, Monsanto vice president Scott Partridge released a statement saying “more than 800 scientific studies and reviews support the fact that glyphosate does not cause cancer.”

However, as noted by Brent Wisner, lead trial counsel for Johnson and thousands of other plaintiffs, those 800 studies did not address carcinogenicity at all. Rather, they were studies looking at safety issues such as whether the chemical causes eye irritation or skin rashes and other random effects.

Only 13 animal studies and half a dozen epidemiological studies have looked at the chemical’s carcinogenic potential, and the vast majority of those studies actually show a correlation between glyphosate — the active ingredient in Roundup — and cancer. They show it causes tumors in mice, and that it causes Non-Hodgkin lymphoma and genetic damage in humans.

It was evidence such as this that in 2015 led the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) — the cancer research arm of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the “gold standard” in carcinogenicity research — to classify glyphosate as a “probable human carcinogen.”

In response, Monsanto launched an all-out attack on IARC and its researchers, and even lobbied to strip IARC of its U.S. funding. The American Chemistry Council, of which Monsanto is a member, also formed a front group called Campaign for Accuracy in Public Health Research,²⁷ for the express purpose of discrediting the IARC and seeking to reform the IARC Monographs Program, which evaluates and determines the carcinogenicity of chemicals.

Monsanto has also fought California’s Environmental Protection Agency’s Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment in court, trying to prevent the agency from adding glyphosate to its list of chemicals known to cause cancer.

Under California’s Proposition 65, all such chemicals must bear a warning label informing consumers of the potential risks. So far, the company’s attempts have all failed, and glyphosate-containing products will indeed be required to carry a cancer warning when sold in California.

The film also talks to Carey Gillam, a veteran investigative journalist and author of *'Whitewash — The Story of a Weed Killer, Cancer and the Corruption of Science,'* who has previously gone on record about how Monsanto tried to discredit her for writing critical pieces about the company and its toxic products.³⁰

As noted by Gillam, scientific corruption is widespread, and few of those 800 studies that Monsanto clings to are in fact done by unbiased and independent researchers. Doubts about the science actually arose as early as the 1970s, when Monsanto hired a company called Industrial Biotech Laboratories to conduct some of the safety research required for approval in the U.S.

The lab got caught up in a fraud scandal as it was discovered the researchers had doctored much of the data. After an investigation, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) declared the study results invalid. A study done in the mid-1980s subsequently led the EPA to classify glyphosate as “possibly carcinogenic to humans,” but Monsanto refused to accept the findings.

After nearly a decade of strife, the EPA decided to go against the findings of its own toxicologists and declared glyphosate was not likely to be a human carcinogen. However, several EPA scientists refused to sign that final report. Kraven Laboratories, another lab hired by Monsanto to conduct its research, was also caught falsifying test results, not only for Roundup but also for other pesticides. Fifteen Kraven Lab employees were either fined or imprisoned as a result.

Monsanto has long argued it was a victim of fraud and had to spend large sums of money to redo the falsified studies. However, according to Gillam, it's extremely difficult to ascertain which of those studies have in fact been redone, and which studies our regulatory agencies have relied on. The film also reviews how Monsanto pushed Roundup using false advertising that grossly overstated its safety.

Monsanto never did necessary cancer testing, as the Monsanto Papers reveal the company's own employees were concerned about (and helped cover up) Roundup's potential risks for decades. For example, in a 2003 email, Monsanto lead toxicologist Donna Farmer, Ph.D., writes, *“You cannot say that Roundup is not a carcinogen ... we have not done the necessary testing on the formulation to make that statement.”*

In 2014, when Monsanto learned IARC was planning to investigate glyphosate's carcinogenic potential, Farmer wrote, *“... what we have long been concerned about has happened. Glyphosate is on for an IARC review...”* Internal documents also reveal how Monsanto orchestrated the campaign to discredit IARC's findings ahead of time.

As noted in the film, if Monsanto was so sure about the safety of its product, why would it preplan a campaign to discredit the IARC's findings before the scientific review was even

completed? In response, Partridge claims the company was simply preparing to educate the public about the truth, as it knew glyphosate “would be besmirched” by inaccurate conclusions. IARC scientists disagree, saying they were merely following well-established toxicology procedures; they looked at the evidence, and came to a conclusion that fit the evidence at hand. One of the tactics used to counter IARC’s findings was to publish a ghostwritten review that supported glyphosate’s safety.

To this end, Monsanto convened a “panel of independent experts” and tasked them with reviewing the data and publishing an analysis of the evidence. However, email correspondence reveals William Heyden, safety lead for Monsanto, actively wrote and edited the review himself. All of this evidence was shown during Johnson’s jury trial, and these outright lies are ultimately what prompted the jury to award such extensive punitive damages.

Part of Monsanto’s defense of glyphosate still hinges on the EPA’s ruling that the chemical is “not likely to be carcinogenic” to humans, but evidence reveals Monsanto had a strong hand in shaping the EPA’s views as well. Following strong criticism, the EPA convened a scientific advisory panel to reanalyze the scientific evidence and evaluate the strength of its decision that glyphosate is an unlikely carcinogen.

A four-day-long panel meeting was held in December, 2016, and right from the start, some of the experts expressed concerns about the quality of the EPA’s analysis. Some said the agency had violated its own guidelines by discounting data showing a positive association between glyphosate and cancer, while others questioned exclusion of data showing statistical significance.

Pointed questions were also raised about the chemical industry’s influence over regulators. As a general rule, peer-reviewed, published research, especially by independent scientists, tend to carry more merit than unpublished industry research.

But as discussed in the film, CropLife America, which represents Monsanto and other agribusinesses, demanded the EPA remove nationally recognized epidemiologist Peter Infante, Ph.D., from the scientific advisory panel, claiming he was incapable of impartiality because he would give more weight to independent research than industry studies.

The EPA complied, booting Infante off the panel. He still made an appearance at the meeting, though, and in his testimony, Infante urged the advisory panel not to ignore “impressive evidence” linking glyphosate to Non-Hodgkin lymphoma. In the film, Infante says he agrees with the IARC review, which found evidence of carcinogenicity, but denies anti-industry bias.

The film also discusses email correspondence showing an EPA official colluded with Monsanto to prevent the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR), which is part of the U.S. Health and Human Services Department, from conducting an investigation into glyphosate.

The EPA official in question was Jess Rowland, a key author of the EPA's report that found glyphosate was unlikely to be carcinogenic to humans. At the time, Rowland was the associate director of the EPA's Pesticide Health Effects Division. Email correspondence between EPA toxicologist Marion Copley and Rowland suggests Rowland may in fact have colluded with Monsanto to find glyphosate noncarcinogenic in the first place.

In one email Copley cites evidence showing glyphosate is toxic to animals, adding "It is essentially certain that glyphosate causes cancer." She directly accuses Rowland of playing "political conniving games with the science" to help Monsanto and other pesticide manufacturers. There's also evidence showing Rowland warned Monsanto of the IARC's determination months before it was made public,³⁷ which gave the company time to plan its attack on the IARC.

As for the ATSDR investigation, Monsanto regulatory affairs manager Dan Jenkins recounts a conversation he'd had with Rowland in an email, in which Rowland said, "If I can kill this I should get a medal,"^{38,39} referring to the ATSDR investigation. Jenkins also wrote, "I doubt EPA and Jess can kill this, but it's nice to know they're going to actually make the effort."

As it turns out, his pessimism was unwarranted. Another Monsanto memorandum notes the ATSDR "agreed, for now, to take direction from EPA," showing Rowland did in fact succeed in his mission to thwart the ATSDR's investigation of glyphosate.

By colluding with Monsanto to declare glyphosate safe and stopping toxicology evaluations by other federal offices, the EPA has used taxpayers' money to hide the truth about a dangerous toxin and prevent consumers harmed by the chemical from being able to effectively prove their case in court. But despite such collusion, Johnson was able to make his case against Monsanto, and he's not the only one. Another 9,000 plaintiffs are waiting for their day in court.

While the Monsanto name has been retired, its toxic legacy will remain for decades to come. As noted by Johnson's attorney, Wisner, nearly all chemicals produced over the past 100 years that have been shown to be extraordinarily toxic can be traced back to Monsanto, including DDT, PCBs, dioxins, Agent Orange and now glyphosate.

"Monsanto effectively made a business out of poisoning people, and getting away with it," Wisner says. "For the last 20 or 30 years, Monsanto has engaged in a systematic and deliberate campaign to attack any science that says their product is not safe, and to attack any scientist that has the courage to say something. They have a corporate culture that has zero interest in safety. It has only an interest in maintaining the ability of them to sell this product."

I hope the reader is beginning to see the link between policies of The Club of Rome, as far back as 1968 was focused on "depopulation", and implemented by sovereign states agencies like the U.S. State Department and population control, including health agencies such

as the CDC and EPA working closely with Big Pharma, Big Foods, Big Chemical, are withholding health data from the public knowledge, and contributing to “Killing us Softly”. In the next segment we will look at another toxic product in the things we drink.
